INTRODUCTION

Livestock has remained an integral part of socio-economic fabric of rural India since times. It is a source of livelihood and a provider of drought energy, manure and fuel. These functions, however, are changing in importance with economic development. Sustained rise in income and urbanization is now fueling rapid growth in demand for animal food products, and the livestock is coming under pressure to produce more. India's livestock has responded well to these changes. Over the last three decades livestock production grew faster than crop sector and made significant contribution to agricultural growth. Therefore, in India a growing livestock sector augurs well for the low-income households to augment their income and escape poverty. Indian livestock sector is characterized by large number of small-scale livestock producers. These small-scale livestock producers are constrained by lack of access to markets, credit, inputs, technology and services which may deter them from taking advantage of the opportunities resulting from the expanding demand for animal food products in the domestic and global markets. Low level of public investment in the livestock sector is detrimental to the interests of millions of poor livestock producers. Value addition to livestock production is not encouraging and may constrain the growth of livestock production, especially amongst small-scale producers. Therefore, concerted production and post-production initiatives are required to improve the lot of livestock producers. The proposed summer school is aimed to bring together the expertise on various aspects of production and post production initiatives to augment livestock production and productivity

HOST INSTITUTE

Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology of Kashmir is a multi-campus University dedicated to teaching research and extension in temperate and cold arid agro climatic regions of Kashmir and Ladakh. The main campus which houses the University Governance and Faculty of Horticulture is located at Shalimar Srinagar. Faculty of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry is located at Shuhama, at a distance of 18 Km from City Centre (Lalchowk) towards North East, 32 Km from Airport and 7 Km from University Headquarters.

COMPONENTS OF SUMMER SCHOOL

Summer School shall comprise of expert lectures by the Faculty of SKUAST-Kashmir, practical demonstrations and field visits besides group discussions and invited lectures by experts from other universities/institutions. Participant evaluation shall form an important part of the summer school

EVALUATION OF PARTICIPANTS

Each participant shall make a presentation on the theme. Besides quizzes shall be conducted at regular intervals. Based on presentation and periodic evaluation, best participant(s) shall be felicitated.

ELIGIBILITY

Summer School shall be open to all applicants working in the college/University/KVK not below the rank of Assistant Professor. The summer school shall be useful for all Veterinary and Animal Science subjects particularly Livestock Production and Management, Animal Sciences, Poultry Sciences, Animal Nutrition, Animal Physiology, Animal Breeding and Genetics, Animal Reproduction & Gynecology, Veterinary and Animal Husbandry Extension and Livestock Products Technology.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Candidates desirous of participating in the summer school should apply on line through CPB portal <https://cbp.icar.gov.in/> A non-refundable fee of Rs 50 can be paid through Demand Draft/Postal Order favoring Course Director, Summer School, Division of LPM, FVSc & AH, SKUAST-K Shuhama, Alusteng, Srinagar.

Participants will be selected on the basis of their ability to benefit from the programme and their capacity to develop as teachers of agriculture & allied sciences.

The maximum number of participants would be 25 (Twenty Five)

Candidates shall be informed of their selection by 15th May 2018 after which they need to confirm their participation within the weeks time to enable selection from the waitlisted candidates.

Non-participation after confirmation shall be treated as ethical misconduct.

TRAVEL, ACCOMMODATION & FOOD

Selected outstation participants shall be paid TA limited to AC-II class/ Bus fare as per the eligibility and on production of tickets.

Accommodation in university guest house on sharing basis shall be provided.

Participants are requested not to bring spouses/accompanying persons.

Organizers shall try to provide sumptuous food and refreshment to participants during the course.
